

Dear friends,

I am not sure to come to AGM this year. I am afraid it could be lost time and lost money. I am very sorry to write this, but I agree with the opinion of Romania. I hoped that more information and more discussion could be open with new executive during the hole year. See the agenda form the last year.

To move the things forward I think we have to discuss following areas (see the report of AGM 2009):

- Missing any fresh news about the work of president and executive.
We recommend AGM to pass a resolution: **AGM binds a president to publish regular report (minimum 4 x per year = quartly period)**. Included information like Olympic movement, WMSG, IGF etc.
- **European rating system open only for national go association members.**
We recommend AGM to pass a resolution: **AGM binds executive to open discussion about this topic as the basic for any kind of decision made on AGM 2011.**
- The problem of EGCC is that we don't have any relevant information about the work and economy.
We recommend AGM to pass a resolution: **AGM binds EGCC to publish yearly annual report of a EGCC with detailed utilization of the budget, 2009 the first one.**
- Treasurer report: We have no informations before AGM. Budget articles for this year (2009-2010) = utilisation = how are the money used in the articles? Without this economic information we cannot make any kind of decision in preparation of new budget for 2010 - 2011. Any kind of dusczssion about a budget is missing.
Was the decision about new membership fees good or not? How it was paid by each country?
We recommend AGM to pass a resolution: **EGF executive will publish the utilization of the budget at least 3 months before AGM.**
- No auditor's report from the past time. That means **we didn't accept last auditors report from the AGM 2009.**
- Strong Players' Commission: nothing was done (any kind of information is missing).
- Rules of the European Championships deferred to this year: nothing was done (any kind of information is missing).
- We recommend AGM to pass a resolution: **AGM binds organizers to send the budgets of European Championships and Congress to the national associations afterwards.**(I think this decision was made last year but without any success. - It is missing in the report of AGM. But maybe it was just discussed...)

In a lot of points we agree with Romania and we support them:

- No information about the policy and vision of the new EGF leadership.
- No information about activity of EGCC (they have new website from the middle of May, but without any kind of relevant information).
- No information about EGF executive (I mentioned it before).
- We support Romania in a new rule for the EGC organizers, that a **percentage of the tax taken from players should go back to them in form of prizes.** The calculation "how much % it will be" could be done under more detailed financial analysis. We suppose this could be done as soon as possible and it could be prepared for AGM 2011. The previous discussion is recommended.
- We support Romanian idea of a new tournament : **The European Champions League.**

Our point of view:

- We recommend to prepare AGM together with some kind of **workshop and discussion forum for national association leaders**. It seems to be really luxurious to come only for a few hours of AGM in the moment when AGM is quite official meeting. I think there is a lot of things for discussion and a lot of things to do.
- The problem of the AGM is also a language barrier - some people don't understand spoken English quite well and they need to have more detailed **printed materials before the meeting**.
- We recommend to change a **websites of EGF**, which is quite out of date and make a modern platform for the discussion between players, associations, presidents etc. Some idea is coming from Csaba, something could be seen on EGCC website. **Let us support one really professional EGF website** with really good calendar etc. Only <http://www.europeangodatabase.eu> is working well.
