European Cup 2011-2012

The Pandanet European Cup 2010-2011 was the last European Cup sponsored by the Pandanet. The Pandanet sponsorship continues now with the Pandanet European Team Championship and the European Cup (ECup) is currently without a general sponsor. The executive decided to resume the ECup in its old format where tournaments pay for the points they distribute to the top places. The EGF then adds some money to the prize fund created with the point money. This way we hope to keep the ECup alive and have something ready to offer when a new sponsor is found.

A system for the European Championship suggested by British Go Association was accepted in the AGM. The RC completed the details of the system.
