

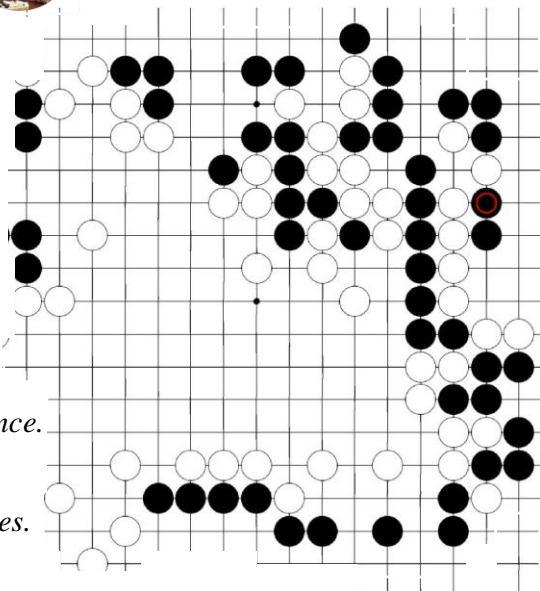
GO THROUGH THE EYES OF YOUTH
