Skype and Online Go Server

# First steps

- Prepare your camera for „side-view” video recording (either by a smartphone or by a web-camera).
- Install Skype (free program) on the smartphone or on a computer connected to the web-camera.
- If you are going to use a smartphone, connect it to the charger!
- Prepare video-recording equipment 10 minutes before the scheduled game (8:50 CET or 14:50 CET).
- The camera (or smartphone) should be set in a way that the video is recording the screen, hands and head of the player.

# Connection – Skype on a smartphone

- Log in to Online Go Server and find the profile of the opponent.
- Start Skype on the phone.
- Click the icon „camer” in top right corner (1).
- The window „Your meeting is ready” shows up.
- Name the meeting, e.g. „EYGC U12 Stjepan Medak” (2).
- Copy the link (3) or find Skype ID under „Skype contacts”
- Copy or type the link into OGS chat with the opponent and send the message using OGS (4)

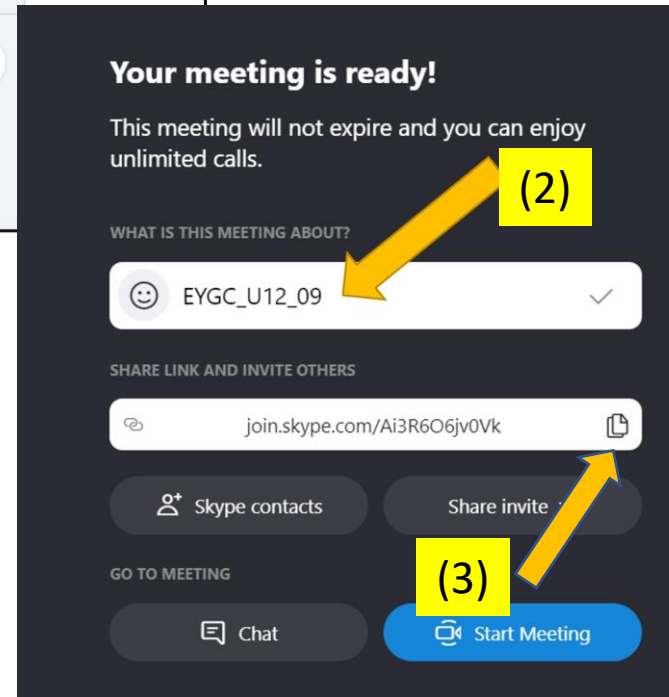
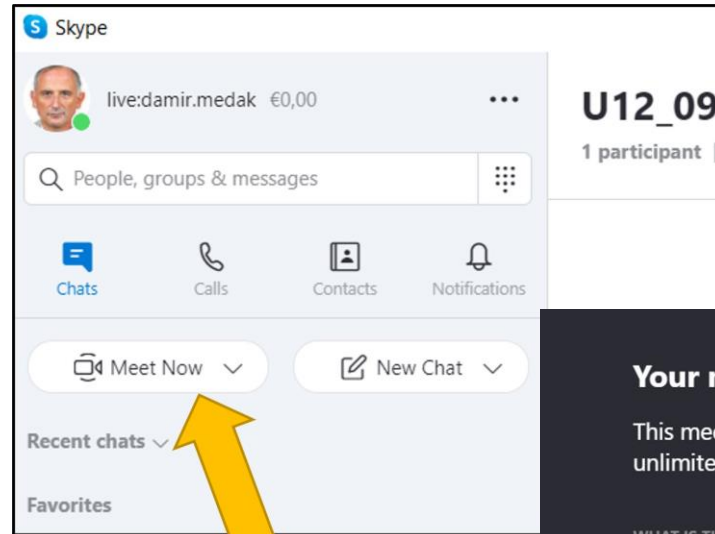


# Connection – Skype on a computer

- Log in to Online Go Server and find the profile of the opponent.
- Start Skype on the computer.
- Click „Meet Now” in top left (1).
- The window „Your meeting is ready” pops-up
- Add the name, e.g. „EYGC U12\_09” (2).
- Copy the link (3) or enter the opponent’s Skype ID under „Skype contacts”
- Copy the link into the OGS chat with your opponent and send the message through OGS (4)
- **In both cases click on „Start Meeting” and start the recording („Record”)**



# After the recording is started

- Open the profile of your opponent in OGS, click „Challenge”
- Under „Game Name” type „EYGC U16” (for example)
- The game **is not** „Private” and it **is not** „Ranked”
- Game speed is „live”, „1 hour” 3 periods of 30 secondy byo-yomi.
- Select appropriate color.
- Say hello to your opponent, present yourself and play fairly!

# If the opponent disconnects or needs a break

- If your opponent accidentally loses connection or asks for a short break, press the „pause” icon (see the yellow arrow).
- At the end of the game, greet your opponent, enter the result in the Tournament Google Sheet and copy the link to the game in the appropriate cell.
- If your opponent entered the data, check it.
- Stop the recording on Skype and – at will – download the video to your computer (the recording is available on the Skype server for 30 days).
