

2020 World Online Youth Mind Sports Fair

Baduk(Go) - Chess - Puzzle - Mental Arithmetic

This tournament is composed by four mind sports. It is organized by Korea Chess Federation and sponsored by Korea Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism, and Korea Sports Promotion Foundation. Here is the information about Baduk(Go) parts.

Schedule

- Opening ceremony: 23th of December 2020, Wednesday 2H CET
- Preliminary League

R1: 20th December 2020, Sunday 10h CET

R2: 20th December 2020, Sunday 14h CET

R3: 27th December 2020, Sunday 10h CET

R4: 27th December 2020, Sunday 14h CET (If necessary: if there is less than 9 people in a section, that section finishes by Round 3)

Finals

Semi-finals: 29th December 2020, Tuesday 11h CET Final: 30th December 2020, Wednesday 11h CET

• **Closing ceremony:** 31st December 2020, Thursday 6h CET (Do not need to attend the opening and closing ceremonies)

WBADUK server

- Go to http://www.wbaduk.com then enter the tournament server.
- Players will be automatically matched once entering the server (do not create game rooms)
- Please install and test the WBaduk client before the 1st round (recommended to install before the registration)

- U06 Born 1st Jan 2014 or later
- U08 Born 1st Jan 2012 ~ 31st Dec 2013
- U10 Born 1st Jan 2010 ~ 31st Dec 2011
- U12 Born 1st Jan 2008 ~ 31st Dec 2009
- U18 Born 1st Jan 2002 ~ 31st Dec 2007
- U23 Born 1st Jan 1997 ~ 31st Dec 2001
- Primary School [1~3 Dan] Born 1st Jan 2008 ~ 31st Dec 2013
- Primary School [4 Dan or above] Born 1st Jan 2008 ~ 31st Dec 2013

Tournament system

- Even game. Basic time 30 minutes, 3x20 seconds per move, Komi 6.5 points, Korean/Japanese rules
- Preliminary: Swiss league. It runs regionally (Europe, Asian, and two tickets for Korean)
- A winner of each preliminary section goes up to the semi-finals.
- Finals: Knock out tournament.



Awards

- All participants will receive a 'Future Talent Certificate' via email.
- Each top 4 of the finals: a certificate of award and small prizes shipped.
- Special prizes for the preliminary league (Europeans)
 - 1st prize: 50 euros of SEYGO voucher
 - 2nd prize: 30 euros of SEYGO voucher

(if there are more than two second places, prize will be not shared and given to both)

- Each preliminary league game is counted for the SEYGO points.

Registration

- Period: 3th December ~ 17 December 2020
- Registration fee: free

- Registration is available for maximum 16 players per each section.

Rules

- No undo may be given to personal mistake such as a mis-click and nondesignation of dead stones.
- up to 3 reconnections after a loss of connection is allowed in (In cases of bad connections, organizer's decision is final)
- Wins by default if opponent does not connect <u>10 minutes after the game starts</u>
- Winners by defaults must receive confirmation message before logging out.
- Mobile Devices (ex. Tablets, smart phones) are not allowed, only PCs can be used.
- In order to prevent cheating (ex. play by proxy, use of AI) all players <u>must show</u> <u>themselves playing live by connecting to Zoom</u>. Player's own image, PC screen and player's hand must be shown on Zoom.
- Future participation and awards will be prohibited if a player is found to have cheated (ex. play by proxy, use of AI)

• Any appeal can be made within 15 minutes after the game ending. (An appeal can be made by sending a message to the organizer)
